1. CONTEXT



CONTEXT

- In 18 years of UNSCR1325: the bedrock of WPS;
- Progress has been made in adoption of policies, protocols, declarations, strategies and action plans



In Africa

- Over 14 instruments by AU
- Over 28 by RECs and REMS – **4 by ICGLR**
- 23 African NAPs – **8 are within the ICGLR**
- 3 RAPs and the **ICGLR draft RAP**

However, Measures to ensure effective, systematic, regular review and reporting have not been put in place



AS a result,

- ✓ Implementation progress is uncertain;
- ✓ Policies, protocols, declarations remain as political pronouncements
- ✓ Peace and security goals are not met

To bridge this gap,

In May 2018, AU PSC adopted the continental results framework (CRF) as a tool to strengthen accountability for the implementation of the WPS agenda in Africa

What is CRF



An African tool to monitor the implementation of the various commitments on WPS in Africa



What Is the CRF

- A research and analytical tool to identify information for WPS reporting
 - A tool to enhance evidence based policy and programme formulation
 - An advocacy tool for enhancing implementation of WPS
- 



What does CRF aim to Achieve

- Systematic and focused monitoring of WPS in Africa
- Identify gaps and barriers
- Accelerate implementation
- Enable coordinated and harmonized Data Collection
- Provide benchmarks



The CRF Indicators

- 41 indicators (28 for MS and 13 for AU)
- Are structured around the four themes of WPS and an addition theme **on emerging security threats**
 - Prevention: 5 indicators
 - Protection: 5 indicators
 - Participation: 11 indicators
 - Relief and Recovery: 7 indicators

How do we strengthen WPS monitoring mechanisms

- Enhance actor coordination for development, implementation, monitoring and reporting at all levels, the CRF provides the opportunity for coordination
- Harmonize data collection mechanisms and tools at all level;
- Enhance capacity for NAP monitoring and data collection
- Advocate for resource allocation
- Localization of NAP implementation and monitoring
