Conflict prevention strengthened

Meaningful women's representation and participation at all levels of decision making increased

Women and their rights protected

Women and girls' engagement and capacities in post conflict relief and recovery enhanced

If women are informed and engaged in all conflict prevention, management processes at national and regional levels as negotiators, mediators, policy formulation

If systems, procedures/mechanisms are established and harmonised to address impunity and violation of HR, VAW and SGBV

If strong coalition of women from community, to intermediary to national, regional level exist and engage with conflict prevention processes

If resources are flexible, available and accessible to women's organising to prepare their participation in all conflict management and peace processes

If women, particularly young women are in leadership position in political systems and security sector

If increased attention is provided and political space open for women's participation

If institutional mechanisms and structures (justice, police, army, are able to identify threats against women's security, safety, health, education of women and girls in conflict and post conflict

If laws and policies are harmonised and accountability mechanisms are put in place to end impunity

If genuine cooperation and collaboration and mutual learning between Great Lakes MS leads to harmonised policy on protection within borders/ across borders

If the security sectors are gender responsive

If women special needs and interests are identified and taken into consideration in post conflict (DDR, justice), humanitarian (repatriation, rehabilitation) development (livelihoods, economic empowerment)

If planning and funding of relief and recovery respond to the needs of women and girls

If post conflict institutions and processes of peace consolidation fully engage women and acknowledge their needs
