

UN System - Wide Strategy on Gender Parity

A strategy on gender parity has recently been shared with UN agencies. It is noted that upon taking office, the Secretary-General made a commitment to reach parity at the senior leadership levels in the UN system. This is achievable with gender mainstreaming in all policy making decisions and would ensure that women access leadership positions.
